

Zelle Hofmann Attorneys Receive Recognition at American Antitrust Institute Awards

The American Antitrust Institute (AAI) recently held its first annual Antitrust Enforcement Awards and the Zelle Hofmann team of Judith Zahid, Qianwei Fu, and Heather Rankie received an Honorable Mention in the Law Practice Category for their work on the *In re TFT-LCD* Antitrust Litigation, by far the largest all-cash indirect purchaser settlement in history, and one of the largest in any private civil antitrust case.
